RTI Guidelines

Testing

- 1. All K-6 students will take four Discovery Education assessments in both Communication Arts and Math throughout the school year.
- 2. Students will be tested in their regular classroom, if he/she is in the classroom for that subject area.
- 3. Students who receive their Communication Arts and Math instruction through special education will test in the Special Education room. In addition, those students will not be placed into groups.

Groups

- 1. In order for any student to be placed into a group, he/she would have to take the Discovery Education test.
- 2. Any student that remains in the regular classroom for instruction in that subject area will be put into a group, if needed. This includes students who receive special education services, but are in the regular classroom for that subject.

Blue

- 1. This group is limited to only two students.
- 2. Two lowest overall test scores

White

- 1. This group is limited to 3-4 students.
- 2. After the Blue Group is determined, the next 3-4 test scores will be placed into the White Group.

Hornets

- 1. All students who were not placed into Blue and White Group will be placed into the Hornet group.
- Any student who receives special education services for either Communication Arts or Math.
